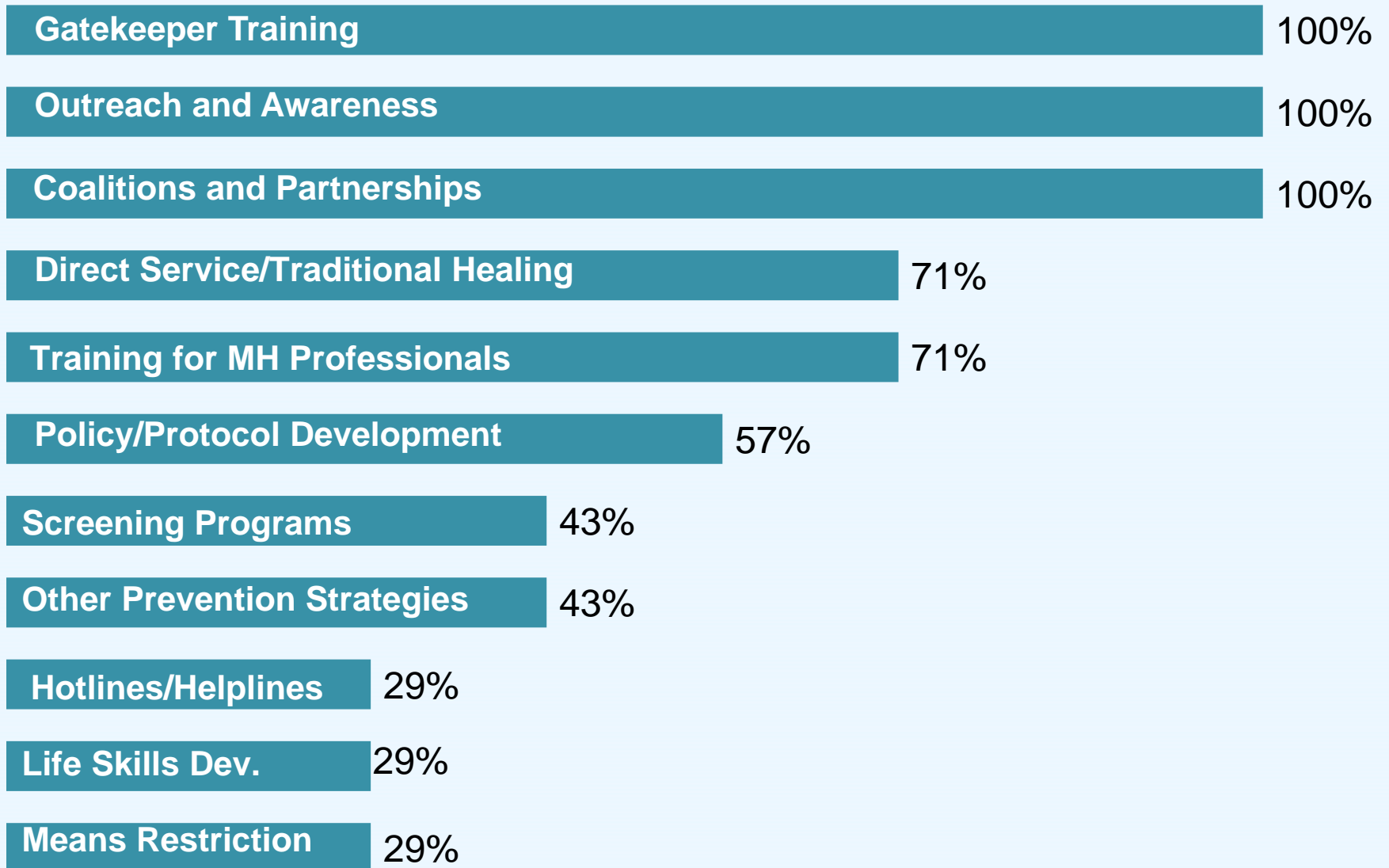

## STATE/TRIBAL COHORT 8 TRAINEES HAVE TRAINED OVER 115,900 INDIVIDUALS, OVER 90% WORK IN AN EDUCATION SETTING



## STATE/TRIBAL COHORT 8 GRANTEES HAVE CONDUCTED 493 TRAININGS

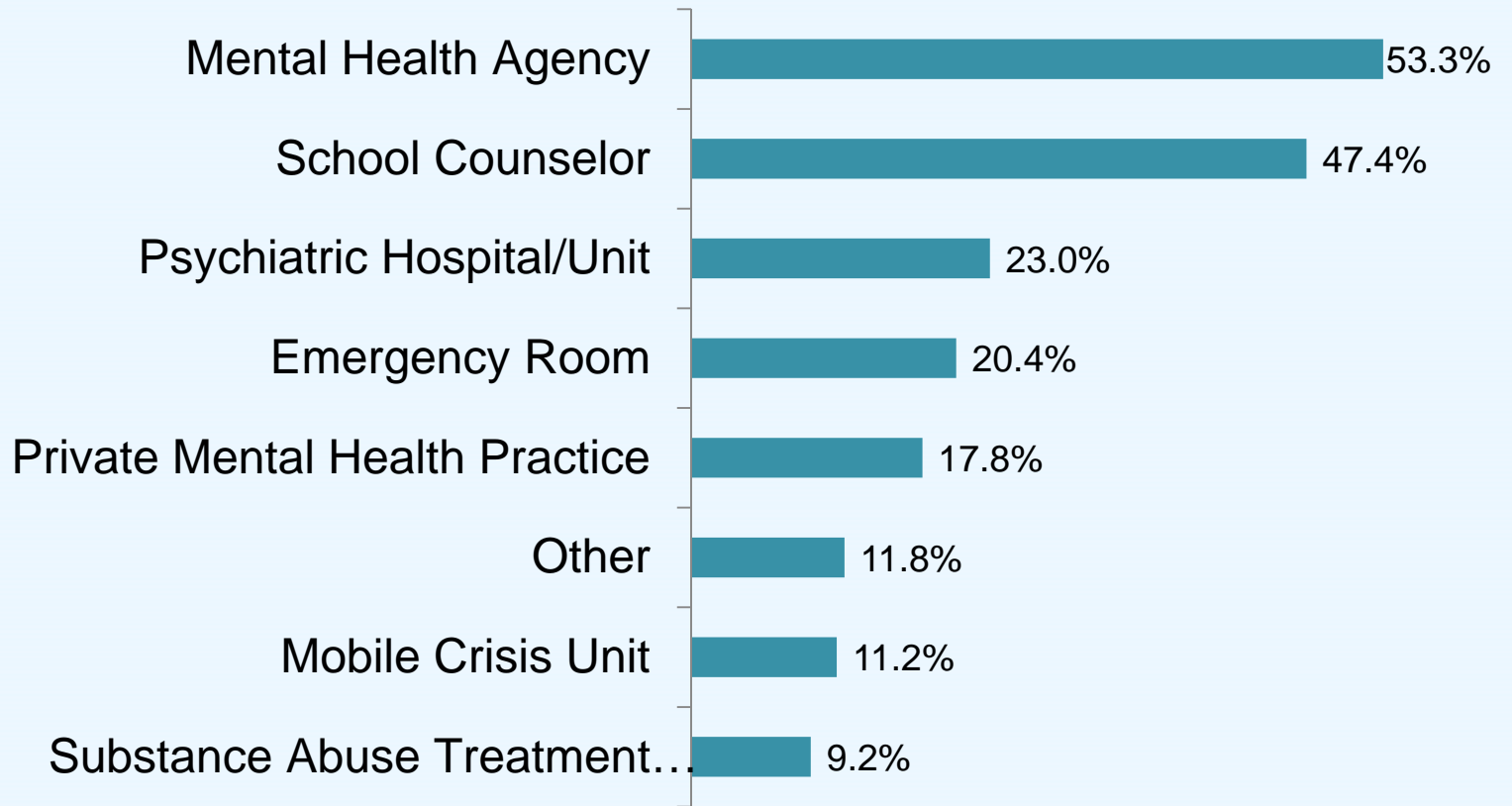

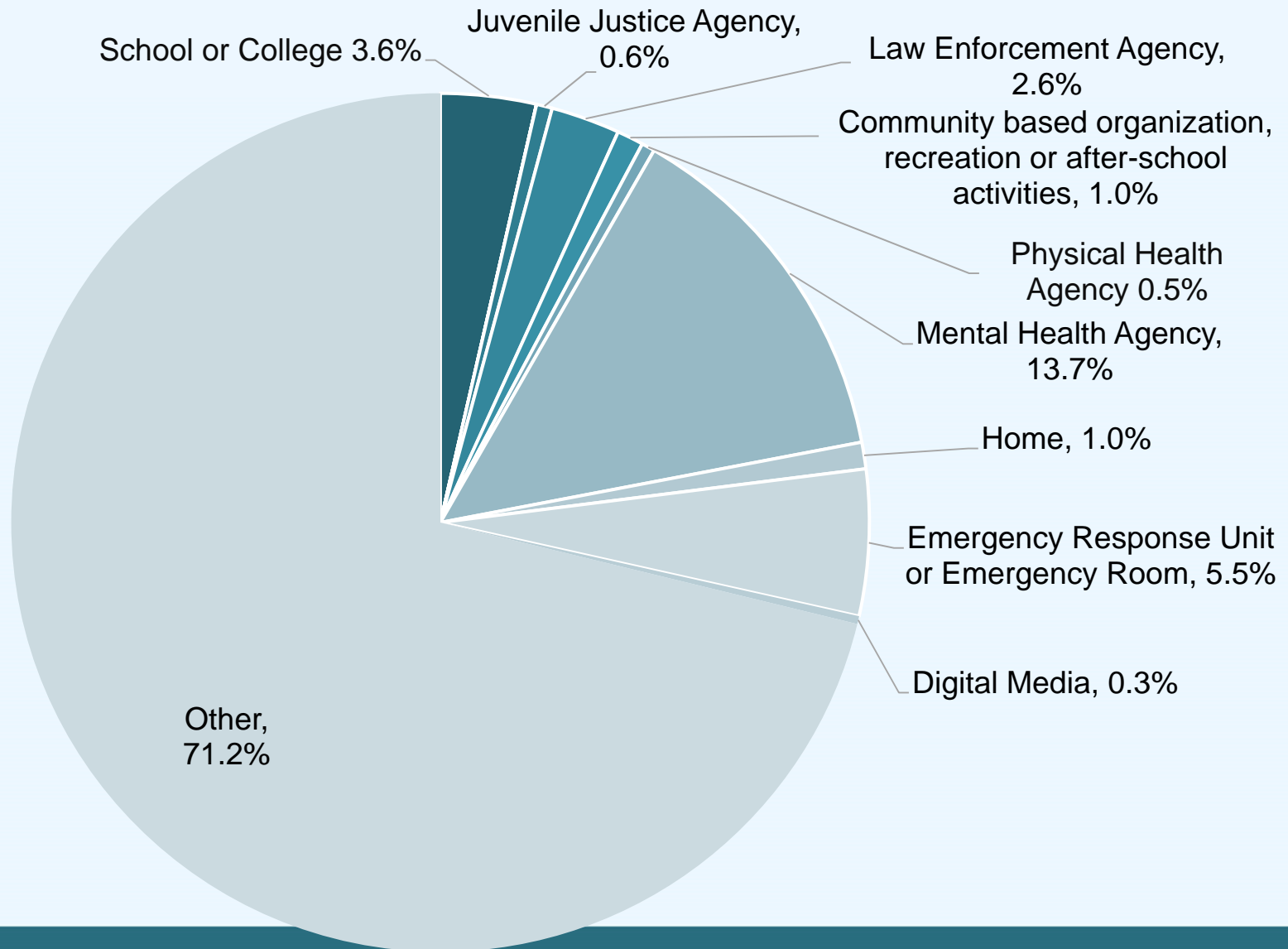
## USE OF TRAINING AT 3 & 6 MONTH FOLLOW-UP

	3-month TUP-S	6-month TUP-S
Have informal conversations about suicide and suicide prevention with youth and others	83.1%	71.4%
Identify youth who might be at risk for suicide	71.6%	60.3%
Make referrals to mental health services for at risk youth	53.2%	44.4%
Provide direct services to youth at risk for suicide and/or their families	50.0%	36.5%
Work with adult at-risk populations	44.9%	39.7%
Formally publicize information about suicide prevention or mental health resources	34.6%	27.0%
Screen youth for suicide behaviors (i.e., using a screening tool)	32.3%	37.1%
Train other staff members	31.5%	28.6%

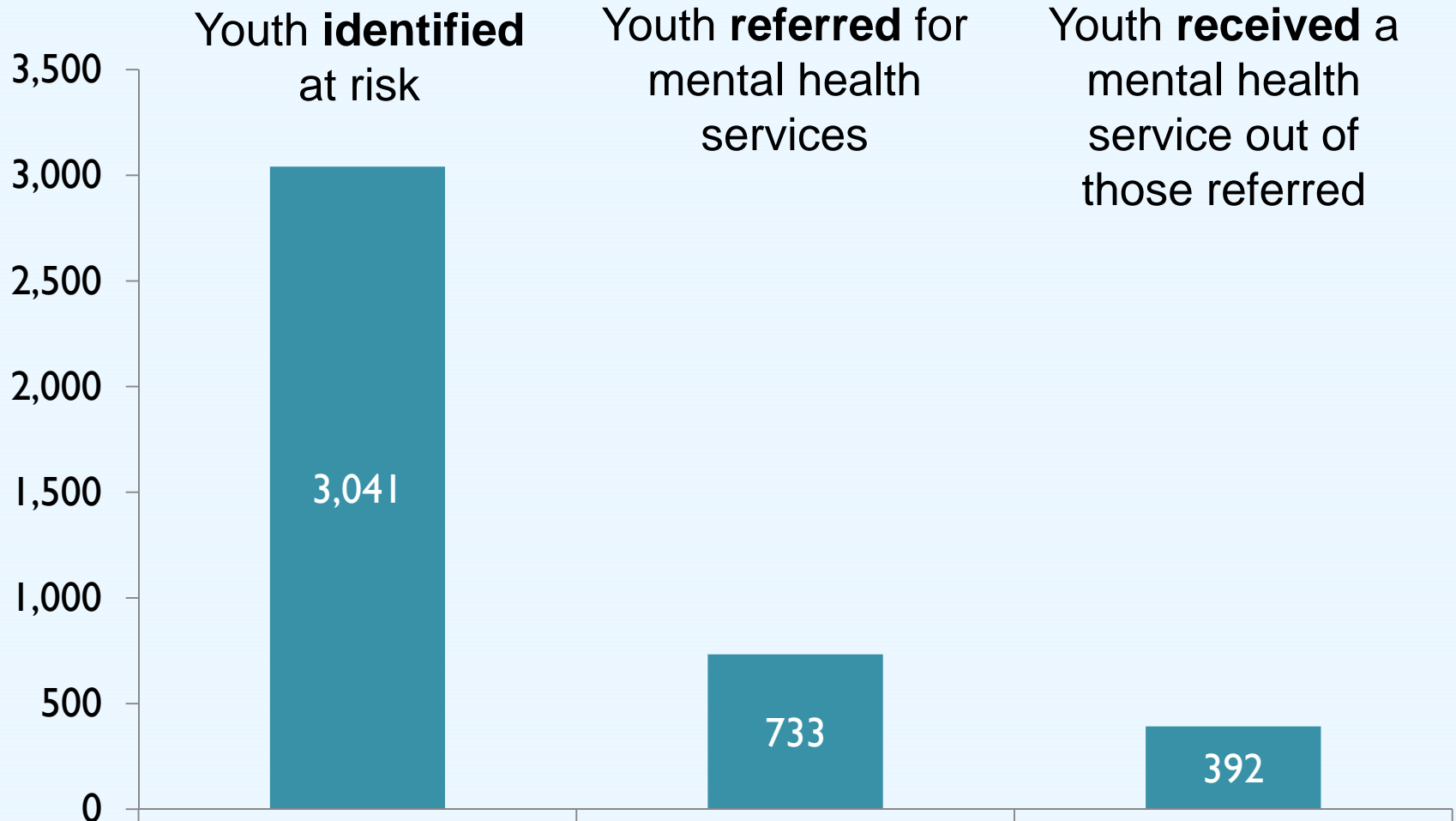
# SERVICES, RESOURCES, OR INDIVIDUALS WHERE AT-RISK STUDENTS WERE REFERRED (N=152)
