 Connecticut


 2004 - Suicide is the second leading cause of death among college students nationwide

## CT Garrett Lee Smith Grant CT Campus Suicide Prevention Initiative

#### Purpose

Develop and implement comprehensive, evidencebased suicide prevention/early interventions on Connecticut campuses.

#### Goal

Reduce suicide contemplation, attempts and deaths of students ages 18-24 attending college in Connecticut.

- Objective 1: Strengthen state and campus capacity and infrastructure in support of mental health promotion and suicide prevention.
- Objective 2: Develop, enhance, implement and sustain suicide prevention practices on Connecticut campuses.
- Objective 3: Conduct a process and outcome evaluation of the initiative.






