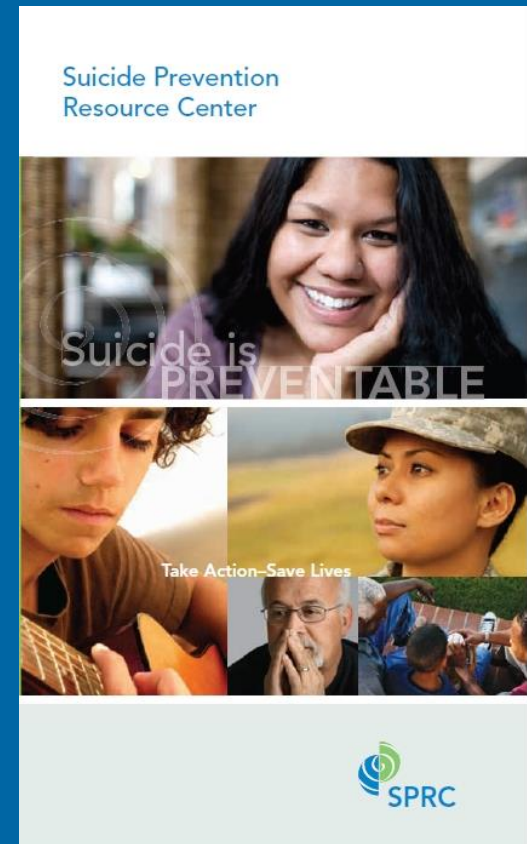
The nation's only federally supported resource center devoted to advancing the *National Strategy for Suicide Prevention*.

Common challenges grantees encounter

- ✓ Staff turnover
- ✓ Planned partners or subcontractors falling through
- ✓ Disconnect between proposal and what's actually needed
- ✓ Low participation in grant offerings (trouble engaging schools, parents, health care organizations, etc.)
- ✓ Bureaucratic obstacles
- ✓ Agency or organizational reorg or leadership change
- ✓ Negative and/or unsafe press coverage
- ✓ Change in cost/availability/acceptability of planned programs
- ✓ Originally planned activities don't seem to be working/well-received
