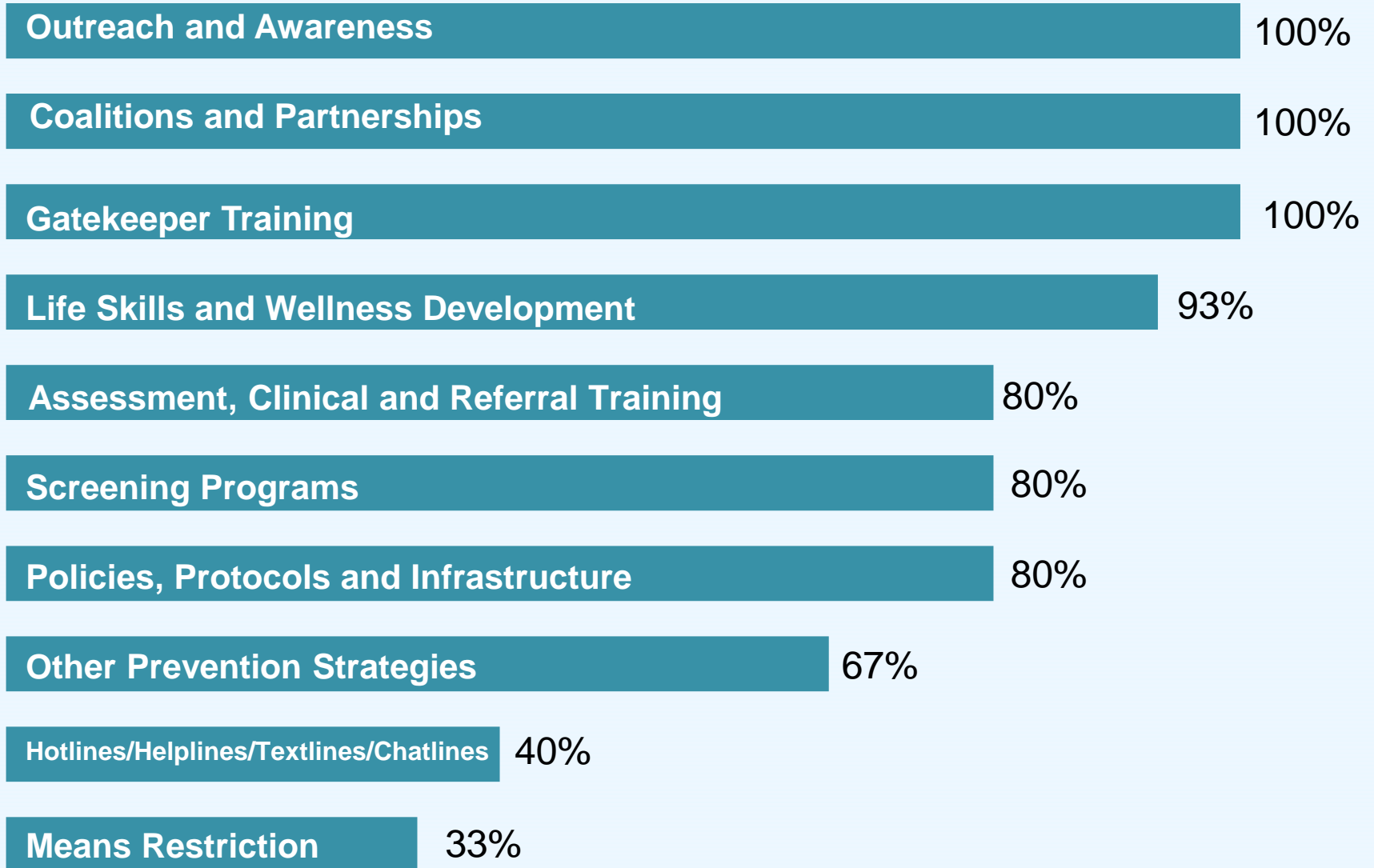

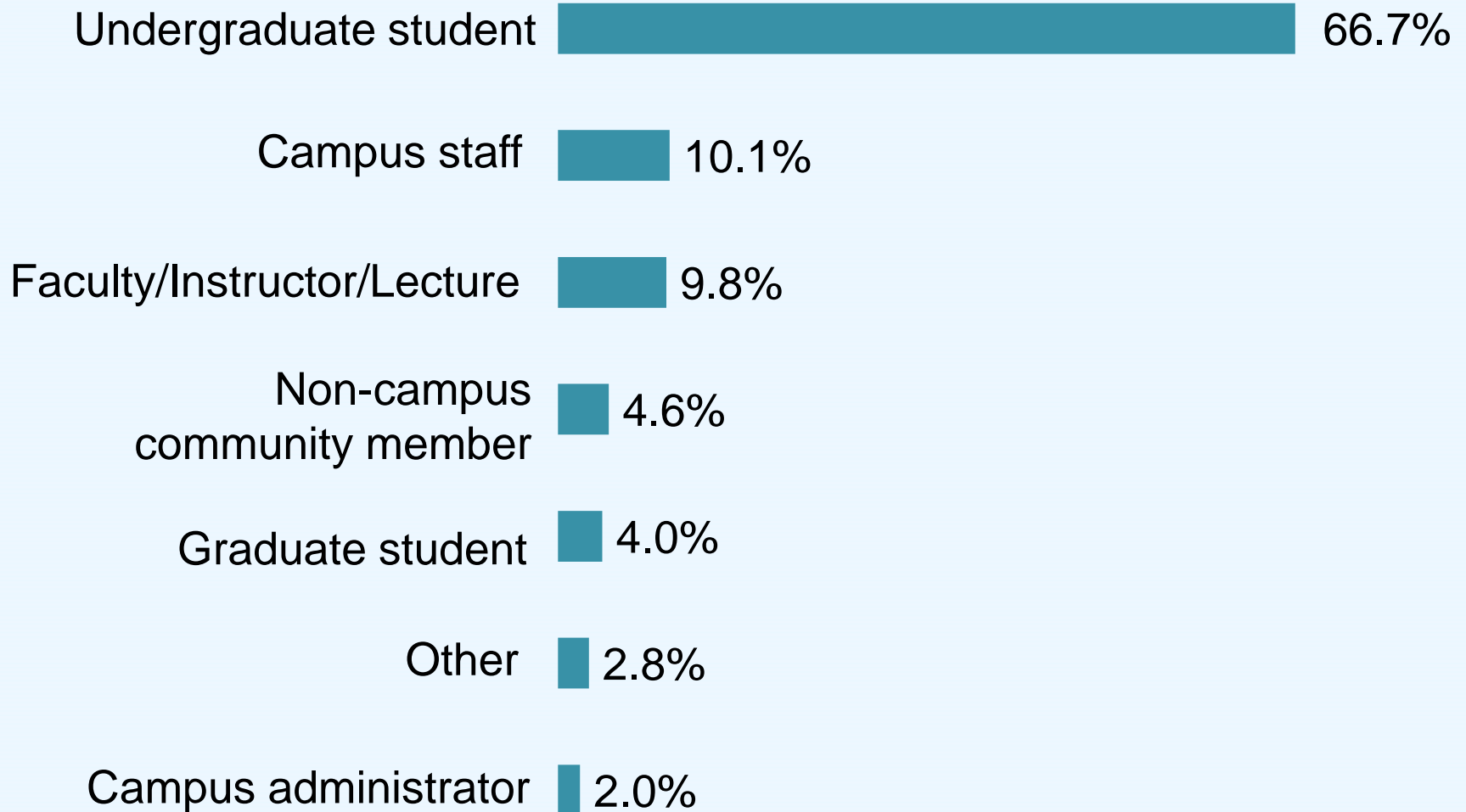


# **COHORT 8 DATA OVERVIEW**

## PSI STRATEGIES FOR COHORT 8 CAMPUS GRANTEES (N=15)



## CAMPUS COHORT 8 GRANTEES HAVE TRAINED OVER 17,115 INDIVIDUALS, NEARLY 70% WERE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS



# CAMPUS COHORT 8 GRANTEEES HAVE CONDUCTED 525 TRAININGS

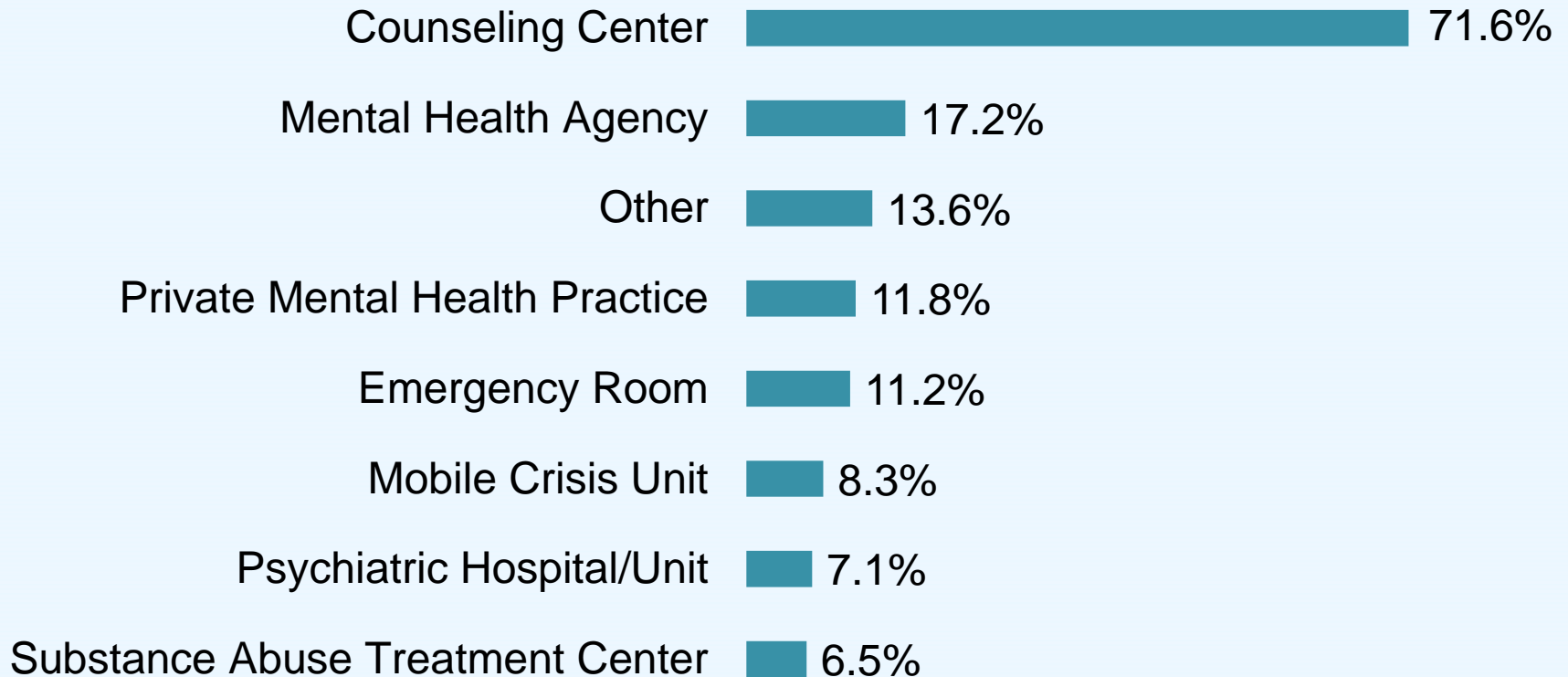

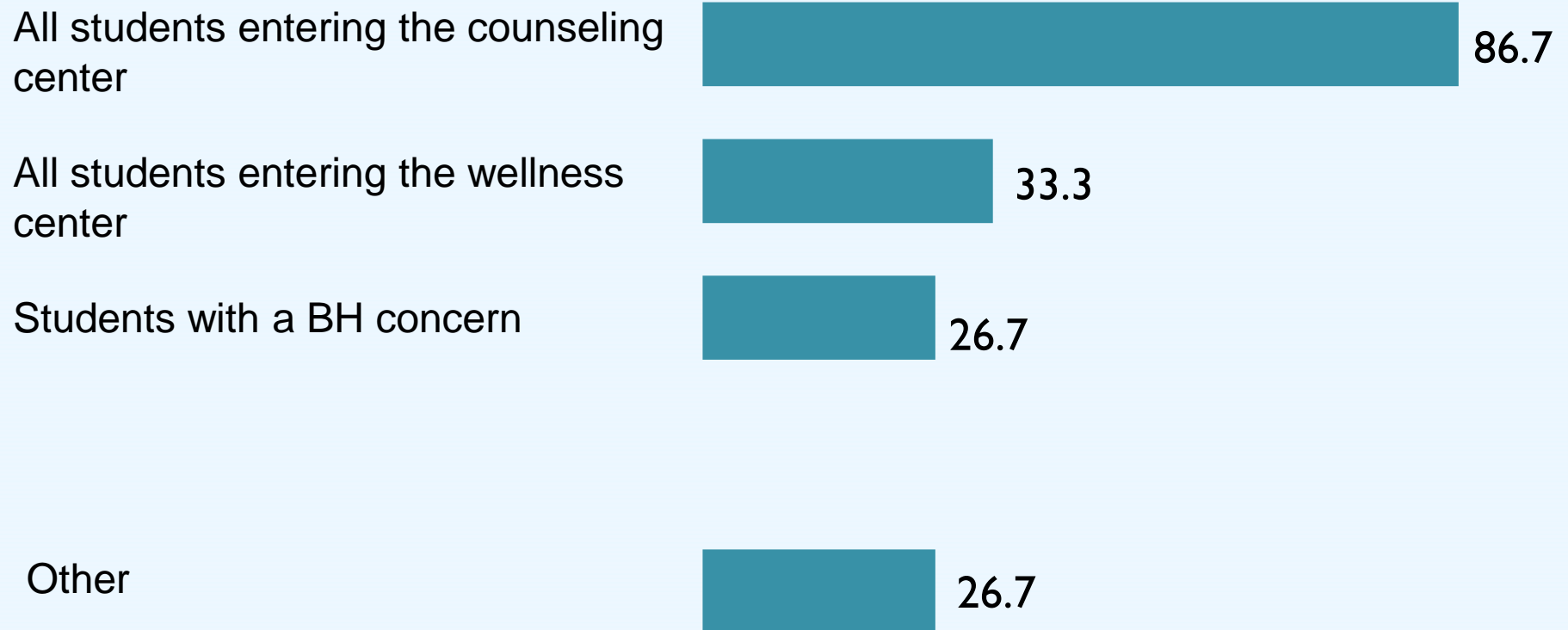
## USE OF TRAINING AT 3 MONTH FOLLOW-UP

Have informal conversations about suicide and suicide prevention with students and others	74.2%
Publicize information about suicide prevention or mental health resources	54.6%
Identify students who might be at risk for suicide	53.2%
Link students at risk for suicide with appropriate services or supports	50.7%
Provide direct services to students at risk for suicide and/or their families	34.3%
Train others	30.4%
Screen students for suicide behaviors (i.e. using a screening tool)	24.6%

Initiation of an on- campus emergency protocol	1.08%	6.67% (n=1)	0% (n=1)	0.18% (n=5)






# How Will Data Be Used
